

DESIGN a voting machine



What is a vote?

When you express a wish to make a certain choice, you are voting.



for example:

 "My brother and I wanted pizza, but everyone else wanted tacos. The vote was 4 for tacos and 2 for pizza, so we had tacos last night."



- "My sister wanted to start the princess movie and stop playing our game. We voted and decided to play one more game of go-fish first."
- I gave my friend's picture a heart on instagram to say I liked it.



• I tried some sour candy and did not like it so I spit it out.

Other people may vote for a different choice than you, and if a group is making a choice together...they count the votes and the choice with the most votes wins.



Challenge:

- Design a voting machine out of any available materials.
- The machine has to register votes in some way and be able to give a result...



for example:

- a box with a hole for colorful bottle lids or caps to drop through
 - the colors represent what the vote is cast for





 a divided holder that represents a vote recipient and objects to put in the holder to represent a vote.
